A: General Conditions	
m 3 states:	"The Licensee shall file a report pursuant to Section 12(1) of the Act and Section 15(1) of the Regulations not later than March 1st of the year following the calendar year reported"
olation: The annual report was received late.	
m 5 states:	"The Licensee shall comply with the surveillance Network Program annexed to this Licence.
olation: The Hamlet of Aklavik did not comply with this requirement for the 1991 calendar year.	
m 9 states:	"The Licensee shall within sixty (60) days of the issuance of this Licence, post and maintain the necessary signs to identify the stations of the Surveillance Network Program to the satisfaction of the Inspector."
olation: The Hamlet of Aklavik did not comply with this requirement for the 1991 calendar year. The SNP Stations were not posted.	

Item 10 states:

"The Licensee shall, within sixty (60) days of the issuance of this Licence, post signs in the area of the water supply facilities and in the areas of the waste disposal facilities to advise the public that these areas are being used for the municipal water supply and for the disposal of municipal wastes. All postings shall be located and maintained to the satisfaction of the Inspector."

Violations:

The Hamlet of Aklavik did not comply with this requirement for the 1991 calendar year. The sewage lagoon and solid waste disposal site was not posted to the satisfaction of the Inspector.

Conditions Applying to Water Use 2. Part B:

No violations were noted under this section of Water Licence N3L4-0570 for the 1991 calendar year.

Part C: Conditions Applying to Waste Disposal

No violations were noted under this section of Water Licence N3L4-0570 for the 1991 calendar year.

Part D: Conditions Applying to Modifications

No violations were noted under this section of Water Licence N3L4-0570 for the 1991 calendar year.

SURVEILLANCE NETWORK PROGRAM

Sampling and Analysis Requirements Part B:

"The effluent at Station 570-3 shall be sampled once immediately after Item 1 states: break-up of the Clearing Lake Sewage Lagoon and once prior to freezeup."
