INTRODUCTION

This report covers the Hamlet of Aklavik's compliance with their Water Licence N3L4-0570 for

the 1993 calendar year.

The scope of this Licence allows for municipal water use and waste disposal at Aklavik, Northwest Territories. Aklavik's Water Licence N3L4-0570 became effective May 1, 1989 and expires April 30, 1999.

INSPECTIONS

WATER LICENCE N3L4-0570 1993 COMPLIANCE REVIEW

General Conditions Part A:
