The new O&M Manual has been filed with the board and that is the only changes to our Operation and Maintenance Plans. The only other plans we have at this time is that we are putting in our budget for 2005/06 plans to put up chainlink fence around the southern area of the waste disposal site complete with an entrance gate. If we get this completed it will secure the site.
