NORTHWEST TERRITORIES WATER BOARD REASONS FOR DECISIONS

Issued Pursuant to Section 26 of the Northwest Territories Waters Act, Chap. 39, R.S.C

LICENCE NUMBER: N7L3-1619 (TYPE "B")

This is the decision of the Northwest Territories Water Board with respect to an application for a Licence dated the third day of March 22, 1994, made by:

The Incorporated Hamlet of Paulatuk General Delivery Paulatuk, Northwest Territories XOE 1NO

for: Water use and waste disposal for Municipal Undertakings at Paulatuk, Northwest Territories.

With respect to this application, notice was given in accordance with Section 23 of the Northwest Territories Waters Act. There was no Public Hearing held in connection with this application.

DECISION

After having been satisfied that the project had been screened pursuant to the Environment Assessment and Review Process Guidelines Order (1984) and that any potentially adverse environmental effects were insignificant or mitigable with known technology and, as such, the application could proceed through the regulatory process and after reviewing the submission of the Applicant and after reviewing the written comments received by the Board; the Board, having due regard to the facts and circumstances, the merits of the submissions made to it and to the purpose, scope and intent of the Northwest Territories Waters Act and Regulations made thereunder determined that:

Licence Number N7L3-1619: be issued subject to the terms and conditions contained therein.

The Board's reasons for this decision are as follows:

- There is an obvious requirement that the municipality provide water and sewage services to its residents.
- No objection by any person to the issuance of this Licence was made known to the Board.

The Board realizes that Licence Number N7L3-1619 is a lengthy document containing many specific provisions which the Board feels necessary to ensure and monitor compliance with the Northwest Territories Waters Act and the Regulations made thereunder and to provide appropriate safeguards in respect of the applicant's use of the waters affected by the Licence. The Board will provide reasons for decision for any specific clause or clauses contained in the Licence if requested to do so in writing.
