Mackenzie Delta/Richards Island area near the Kendall Island Bird Sanctuary. Watercourse to be crossed is the Middle Channel of the Mackenzie River. All crossings will be during frozen conditions, not requiring permanent structures. No waste deposits will be made as all wastes will be incinerated at camp when possible. All other wastes will be transported to Inuvik for disposal in an approved landfill.

Approximately 11 m³/day of waste to be deposited. Electric toilets will be used to dispose of camp sewage. Camp grey water (shower and dish water) will be frozen within temporary snow bermed holding areas and then spread across ground when camp mobilized. All wastewater criteria will be at or below *Guidelines for the Discharge of Treated Municipal Wastewater in the Northwest Territories*.
