
Please find the enclosed Inspection/Audit Report for your review and/or records.



- Site was acceptable during the February 27, 2001 Water Licence Inspection with the exception the garbage incinerator leaving a fallout plume over camp. Site was acceptable during subsequent Land Use Inspection/Permit Closure.
- Incinoleet toilets were used to dispose of camp sewage. Grey water was stored in a snow berm at the camp location and when the camp moved the berm was destroyed and the water was spread evenly along the ground. Grey water was also put through a steamer and the remaining amount was hauled by vacuum truck to the Inuvik Waste Facility.
- Non-combustible garbage was hauled to Tuk and/or Inuvik landfill sites.
