2. It is mention that a private ice road will be used for transportation. The NWT Water Board support staff would like to know if the ice road will be build and maintain by Shell Canada Limited? If so, please provide us with more information regarding the ice road (i.e. quantity of water to be used to build and maintain the ice road, is the quantity of water to be used included in water use per day (150 m3), the length of the road, and the provenance of the water used to build and maintain the ice road).
