Located primarily along the Middle and East Channels of the Mackenzie River and extending into the Caribou Hills. A sleigh mounted base camp is located at 134°18'3" and 68°44'27" for the duration of the program.

Seismic program with associated camp facilities within the Inuvik 1 and 2 Blocks, extending onto EL 385. Seismic program requires ice access within program and along slopes of caribou hills to ensure safe travel and to meet regulatory guidelines for environmental protection.

Seeking temporary amendment to water licence with current quantity of water not to be exceeded set at 100 cubic metres. To ensure adequate ice build-up on access routes within current operational schedule, program requires approximately 500 cubic metres daily for 30 days. Once sufficient ice access has been created, the program can revert to original licenced amount of 100 cubic metres. Water will be obtained from the channels of the Mackenzie River.

Both black water and grey water will be trucked to Inuvik for disposal several times a week as outlined in January 17th, 2002 letter to Water Board. Camp currently has holding capacity for black and grey water until removal by truck.

Cabin owners in the vicinity of the project will be contacted. Community consultation was conducted prior to operation start-up.
