RE: Cape Parry (PIN-M) DEW Line Site - Landfill sites - removal cleanup project - DIAND Type B Water Licence Application


During a meeting held 8-10 April 2002, the Environmental Impact Screening Committee (EISC) screened the above-noted project description. Based on the information provided, the EISC decided that the development will have no significant negative impact on the environment or Inuvialuit wildlife harvesting in the Inuvialuit Settlement Region [IFA Section 11.(13)(a)]. A copy of the decision has been attached.

Subject to a final decision by the licensing or permitting authority, the issuance of appropriate permits and approvals may proceed.

For your information, the EISC screened the initial Cape Parry DEW line site clean-up in its entirety in 1997 and considers the above-noted project to be part of the follow-up monitoring and restoration associated with the initial development. Therefore, by resolution of the EISC the requirement that submissions must be received 30 days in advance of a meeting in order to be screened at a given meeting was waived to allow for screening at the April meeting. Since the 30-day requirement was waived, the Paulatuk Hunters and Trappers Committee did not have the opportunity to forward comments to the EISC prior to the April meeting. As such, it is imperative that the Paulatuk Hunters and Trappers Committee be consulted prior to commencement of the development.

The EISC would appreciate receiving a copy of any follow-up reports that may be produced as a result of this development.

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




