Thank you for speaking with John Hunt and me on Friday with respect to the spill at Nuna I-30. As we discussed, 24 m3 of effluent was discharged into the drilling sump instead of the effluent sump. The effluent is meeting criteria as outlined in the water permit (licence No. N7L1-1788).

As per your request, here is a summary of the recent analytical from the Nuna I-30 effluent:
