Dear Ms. Aho,

Following our conversation on July 6, 2004 Inuvialuit Projects (2003) Inc. wishes to store approximately 4000 US gallons of diesel fuel within the camp barge fuel tanks. These tanks have been certified by Transport Canada in June 2004.

NTCL will be installing a new 45 meter fuel hose that will be equipped to the fuel transfer pump on the barge. A standard fuel nozzle will be attached at the other end for refuelling of equipment, 30 meters away from the Mackenzie River. A drip tray (55 US gallons) will be placed under the equipment during. NTCL and IPI will both have spill equipment on site and emergency response plans in place.
