## NORTHWEST TERRITORIES WATER BOARD REASONS FOR DECISIONS

Issued Pursuant to Section 26 of the Northwest Territories Waters Act, Chap. 39, R.S.A.

LICENCE NUMBER: N7L1-1824 (TYPE "B")

This is the decision of the Northwest Territories Water Board with respect to a Licence issued on September 25<sup>th</sup> 2008 to:

Contaminates and Remediation Directorate, INAC P.O. Box 1500 YELLOWKNIFE, NT X1A 2R3

for: water use and disposal of waste in industrial undertakings at Johnson Point, located at Latitude 72°45'10" N. and Longitude 118°30' W., Northwest Territories.

With respect to this application, notice was given in accordance with Section 23 of the *Northwest Territories Waters Act*. There was no Public Hearing held in connection with this application.

## **DECISION**

After having been satisfied that the project had been screened pursuant to the *Canadian Environmental Assessment Act*, and that any potentially adverse environmental effects were insignificant or mitigable with known technology and, as such, the application could proceed through the regulatory process and after reviewing the submission of the Applicant and after reviewing the written comments received by the Board; the Board, having due regard to the facts and circumstances, the merits of the submissions made to it and to the purpose, scope and intent of the *Northwest Territories Waters Act* and Regulations made thereunder determined that:

Licence Number N7L1-1824: be issued subject to the terms and conditions contained therein.

The Board's reasons for this decision are as follows:

- 1. No objection by any person to the issuance of this Licence was made known to the Board.
- 2. Provided that the Licensee operates in accordance with the terms and conditions imposed by the Licence, the quality of water in any water body within the Licence area should not be impaired.
- 3. The use of water proposed by the Licensee is of a nature contemplated by the *Northwest Territories Waters Act*.

Licence Number N7L1-1824 contains provisions, which the Board feels necessary to ensure and monitor compliance with the *Northwest Territories Waters Act* and the Regulations made thereunder and to provide appropriate safeguards in respect of the Applicant's use of the waters affected by the Licence.
