RE: Johnson Point disposal/recycling location for majority of waste steel and certain non-hazardous waste

As a follow up to my letter of July 17, 2008, please consider this a revision to the waste disposal facilities to be used for the Johnson Point remediation project. To make sure of empty backhauls and create efficiencies in the project, a large portion of the waste metal and non-hazardous material from Johnson Point has been removed from site and is being stored temporarily in Tuktoyaktuk. The current plan is now to dispose of this material with Amix Salvage and Sales from Surrey B.C., as they currently have an empty barge backhaul available. The remaining waste metal will be disposed of as per the original letter unless otherwise notified.

I have attached the acceptance letter from Amix as requested.
