**Re: Shell Canada Energy N7L1-1834 – CAMP FAREWELL**

The Inuvialuit Water Board (IWB) is currently completing a review of Shell Canada Energy's Camp Farewell 2014 Lagoon Remediation report that was submitted on April 29, 2014. As per Part G, Item 1 of the Water Licence (N7L1-1834), within one year of licence issuance (by July 19, 2013), an updated Interim Abandonment and Restoration Plan that includes plans for the abandonment and restoration of the sewage lagoon and a complete Phase II Environmental Site Assessment of Camp Farewell was to be submitted to the IWB for approval. The recently submitted Lagoon Remediation report does not reference a post-licence issuance Interim Abandonment and Restoration Plan nor the associated Phase II Environmental Site Assessment. The IWB requests that Shell Canada Energy confirm whether an Interim Abandonment and Restoration Plan, as per Part G, Item 1 of the Water Licence, was previously submitted for IWB approval.

Additionally, the IWB requests that Shell Canada Energy confirm whether the 2013 Annual Report (due by March 31, 2014), as per Part B, Item 1 of the Water Licence, was previously submitted to the IWB.
