Re: N3L3-0570 Hamlet of Aklavik - Municipal Water Licence - 2019 Annual Report

The Inuvialuit Water Board (IWB) acknowledges receipt on June 26, 2020 of the above-mentioned report. Upon review, information gaps have been identified. As per municipal water licence N3L3-0570, please provide the following information:

- 3. Part B, Item 1h): a description of any closure and reclamation work completed during the year and an outline of any work anticipated for the next year.
- 4. Part B, Item 1j): any updates and/or revisions to the:
 - o approved Spill Contingency Plan;
 - o approved Solid Waste Disposal Facility Operation and Maintenance Plan;
 - o approved Sewage Waste Disposal Facility Operation and Maintenance Plan:
 - o approved Hazardous Waste Management Plan; and
 - approved Closure and Reclamation Plan.
- Part B, Item 1k): results of Hamlet Staff inspections on all Water Supply and Waste Disposal Facilities authorized under this Licence; and any corrective actions, as necessary.
- 6. Part B, Item 1I): all correspondence between the Inspector (i.e. ENR Water Resource Officer) and the Licensee.
