Dear Mr. Krengnektak,

As per your email request dated September 25, 2015, it is understood that the Hamlet of Tuktoyaktuk wishes to decant their Sewage Disposal Facility (the 'sewage lagoon') and Solid Waste Disposal Facility (the 'solid waste site'). The purpose of this decant is to lower water levels in the sewage lagoon and solid waste site to achieve and maintain the required freeboard limits as defined in Water Licence N7L3-0714. It is understood that this decant must occur as there is concern that the structural integrity of the sewage lagoon and solid waste site may be at risk and could lead to an eventual uncontrolled discharge.

Further, the sewage lagoon and solid waste site were sampled on September 16, 2015, to provide for a decant. When the results came back from the lab, the analysis was all within Water Licence discharge criteria.

Due to those factors affecting the excess sewage water being discharged and the concern about the structural integrity of the sewage lagoon and solid waste site, it was decided to allow the decant to maintain the required freeboard limits and ultimately prevent uncontrolled discharges. <u>The Hamlet of Tuktoyaktuk is authorized to discharge based on the following conditions:</u>

- 1. The Hamlet is to provide a detailed log of pump run time including pump rate and total daily discharge in cubic meters (m³). Any discharge of water from the solid waste site shall not exceed a discharge rate of 350 m³ per hour, as required by Part D, Item 13 of the Water Licence;
- 2. The Hamlet is not to discharge water from the solid waste site at the same time as the discharge of sewage effluent from the sewage lagoon as required in Part D, Item 12 of the Water Licence:
- 3. The Hamlet is to discharge from the sewage lagoon as long as needed to achieve the freeboard limit of 1.0 metre as required in Part D, Item 6 of the Water Licence;
- 4. The Hamlet is to discharge from the solid waste site as long as needed to achieve the freeboard limit of 0.5 metre as required in Part D, Item 20 of the Water Licence;



- 5. Discharge as slowly as possible and in a regulated manner. This will allow for high dilution as sewage water slowly moves through the system. Furthermore, do not fully open the sewage decant control structure during the discharge;
- 6. The Hamlet must adhere to all other applicable conditions in the Water Licence.
