Hi Michelle,

I just wanted to follow up on the comments we received from the AHTC regarding the graveyard and water issues to ensure they have been addressed.

I believe you received a copy of the 2005 Aklavik Cemetery Remediation Report (see attached)? According to the report in 2004 all impacted soil in the cemetery was successfully remediated. The project being conducted this summer includes the remediation of all the remaining impacted soil which is located on the former power plant site.

K&D Contracting, under the direction of Matrix Solutions, have constructed an earth berm along the property fence parallel to the cemetery to prevent any water from the former plant site entering the cemetery. K&D will also construct a diversion trench to ensure that water from the former plant site does not enter the cemetery. Any drainage issues in the cemetery and its ditches, unless caused by activities conducted at the former plant site, will need to be corrected by the Hamlet of Aklavik.
