Re: N7L1-1834 - Shell Canada Energy, Camp Farewell and Stockpile Site

The Inuvialuit Water Board (IWB) would like to remind Shell Canada that the Annual Report as required by Part B: General Conditions, Item 1 was due on March 31st, 2017 for the calendar year January 1 to December 31, 2016. To date no report has been received. The IWB also remind Shell Canada of the IWB correspondence dated February 3, 2017 regarding the Environment and Natural Resources Inspection Report of January 24, 2017 (Inspection Date - August 15, 2016) which states:

"MATTERS FOR FOLLOW UP: 2016 Annual Report including an outline of the activities planned for 2017."

The term of the water licence N7L1-1834 expires on July 17, 2017, therefore, if remediation and final abandonment related activities are planned beyond the term of the existing water licence, the IWB require an application for an extension of the term of the existing water licence and include the remediation and final abandonment related activities for Summer 2017. The IWB appreciates the cooperation of Shell Canada Energy in complying with the Terms and Conditions of the Licence. A copy of this letter, including all related correspondence, will be placed on the IWB Public Register.
