Re: N5L8-1841 Imperial Oil Environmental and Property Solutions (E&PS) – Tuk Base Remediation Project - 2025 Annual Report

The Inuvialuit Water Board (IWB) acknowledges receipt of N5L8-1841 Imperial Oil, Tuk Base Remediation Project - 2025 Annual Report. The IWB has completed a review of the 2025 Annual Report, and as a result, additional information and / or clarification is required to consider N5L8-1841 2025 Annual Report complete. Please provide the following additional information and / or clarification:


1. Page 3, Section 2.0 states that *“Between 1 August and 2 August 2025, 0.2 m³ of potable water was used to decontaminate heavy equipment prior to leaving the South Landfill.”* Clarify whether the water used for equipment decontamination was considered contaminated water. Also, was the contaminated water discharged on site, and clarify if it may cause adverse effects on the receiving environment. Provide a description of where and how the water used for heavy equipment decontamination was managed.
2. Page 4, Section 4.0 states that *“A summary of the 2025 Non-Hazardous Waste stored at the Site and a Disposal Plan is presented in Table A.”* However, Table A includes a *“Summary of Care and Maintenance Activities Conducted During the 2025 Summer Field Season,”* not the information identified as 2025 Non-Hazardous Waste stored at the Site and a Disposal Plan. Clarify this discrepancy.
3. Page 4, Section 7.0 states that *“A summary of 2025 Soil used as Backfill is presented in Table B”.* However, Table B includes a *“Storage of 2025 Non-Hazardous Waste at the Site”*, not the information identified as *“Soil used as backfill in 2025”*. Clarify this discrepancy.

As per the IWB document submission standards, please submit two (2) hard copies and two (2) electronic copies (USBs) of the updated 2025 Annual Report and / or clarification,

along with a cover letter and summary table indicating how and where (e.g., page and section numbers) the requested information is addressed. The submitted document, including all related IWB correspondence, will be placed on the IWB Public Register.
