**RE: UPDATED MANAGEMENT PLANS FOR CAMP FAREWELL, INUVIALUIT WATER BOARD
WATER LICENCE N7L1-1834 – SHELL CANADA LIMITED**

Please find attached the Environmental Impact Screening Committee (EISC) approved and updated 2026 Emergency Response Plan (ERP), Spill Contingency Plan (SCP) and Waste Management Plan (WMP) for Camp Farewell, in the Inuvialuit Settlement Region, Northwest Territories (the Site; Water Licence N7L1-1834). The plans have been updated to reflect the proposed activities at the Site between 2026 and 2028, including:

- advancing additional boreholes for soil sampling;
- establishing a Jet A-1 aviation fuel cache;
- temporary storage and operation of a self-contained camp; and
- measures to stem the spread of scentless chamomile.

A new migratory bird sanctuary permit for the Site, including the above activities, was issued in January 2026 (MM-NR-2026-NT-001) and approval was obtained for the above activities from the EISC in October 2025 (Registry File No. 04-25-06).

As per Part B, Condition 12 of the Water Licence, the table below summarizes the updates to the plans.
